Factual Situation: On or about October 28, 2016, a 62-year old man was operating a 2005 Harley Davidson motorcycle, traveling in an easterly direction on Fort Johnson Road in Charleston Co., SC. The defendant was operating a 2008 Ford F-150 pick-up truck traveling in a southerly direction on Camp Road in Charleston CO., SC. Suddenly and without warning, the defendant, while traveling at an excessive rate of speed, disregarded the stop sign at the intersection of Fort Camp and Fort Johnson causing a collision with man resulting in severe injuries and ultimately causing his death.
